## Census Bureau Calendar

March 12 - April 27	<b>The Census Bureau will begin mailing out the first set of information to households</b> and will continue with several rounds of reminder letters to those that did not respond. We want to emphasize that people should respond online or by phone as soon as they get their info. Drive self-response by informing the public that the 2020 Census has begun and that people should participate using available response modes.
March 27 - 29	<b>Census Worship Weekend!</b>
April 1	<b>Census Day</b> - By this date, every household will receive an invitation to participate in the Census.
May - July	<b>Census Takers will visit each household's door</b> that did not yet respond online, by phone, or by mail.
